Easy Reference Guide

1	Obtain serum sample: 3ml - Canine/Feline 5ml - Equine.
2	Complete the relevant allervet® submission form including history and select the test(s) required.
3	Submit the sample and form to NWL.
4	If you have requested UK Screen (+/- Foods), proceed to 5. If you have requested UK Full Environmental panel (+/- Foods), proceed to 6.
5	On receipt of results phone NWL 01253 899215 to open any POSITIVE panels or fax back the "allervet® Expand Panel" request form that accompanies your results.
6	Results will be received in full, including Veterinary Medicines Directorate (VMD) "Special Treatment Certificate" (STC) application form & owner results pack.
7	If you wish to proceed with immunotherapy carefully check the VMD paper work.
8	Complete the necessary sections: Section I: part 3 and part 6 - RCVS number of the Veterinary Surgeon who will be the certificate holder. Section I: part 5 - VMD Vet Practice Number (if known) Section II: part 11- Previous SIC/STC reference number (please contact Kate Simister if you are having difficulty locating this number) Section II: part 16 - Owners Address Section II: part 14 - Weight of the Animal (if known) Section IV: Declaration, sign, date and state status within the veterinary practice.
9	Submit the paperwork to the VMD, in the pre-addressed envelope, and await STC, this may take up to 10 working days.
10	On receipt of STC, <u>FAX</u> a copy to NWL along with the allergen specific immunotherapy "Initial Treatment" order form. Fax: (01253) 891934.
11	Immunotherapy should arrive within 4 weeks; the initial treatment lasts approximately 5 months, maintenance treatment lasts approximately 10 months.
12	When you have 4 weeks of initial treatment left fax the "Maintenance Treatment" order form to NWL to continue with immunotherapy.
